Customer Prepare – Mosquito Management and Knockdown

Reducing the mosquito concentration on your property

Prior to your service:

- Please ensure general housekeeping is carried out prior to the service. This includes washing down outdoor furniture and building entrances. Outside treatment is more effective if dust is removed.
- You can be present during the service if only the exterior is being treated.
- If a member of the household is pregnant or may suffer from respiratory complaints, it is advisable that they vacate the premises for a minimum of 4 hours after treatment. It is recommended that the same instructions are applied to babies and young children, particularly those that are still at the crawling stage.
- Ensure all windows and doors are closed prior to and during treatment. Keep these closed until treatment spray has dried.
- It is advised that pets such as dogs, cats, rabbits and guinea pigs, be isolated from treated areas until all surfaces are dry.

- A qualified Adelaide Pest Control technician will complete a site risk assessment and provide you with a full treatment report, including recommendations for future prevention of mosquito activity to your property.

Mosquito Facts

- Mosquitoes can develop from eggs to adults in as little as 7 days in 5ml of water
- Females require a blood meal to develop eggs
- Mosquitoes can carry diseases that may be passed on to people
- On average, a female mosquito will live for 2-3 weeks
- Nuisance mosquitoes are poor fliers and rest before and after taking a blood meal

Steps to take-

- Light coloured clothing and personal repellent is recommended to complement Rentokil treatments.
- Ensure that water does not stand for more than 7 days straight as this provides perfect breeding grounds.
